## CALL FOR NOMINATIONS 2023 Outstanding Doctoral Student Award Nomination Deadline: January 15, 2023

### Purpose

The Outstanding Doctoral Student Award recognizes rising graduate members of the CSCC community for their innovative scholarship that contributes to the national body of knowledge on community colleges; engagement in scholarly activities; and leadership roles within the academy that advocate for the advancement of community college research and practice.

### Eligibility

Open to all current doctoral students (Ed.D./Ph.D.). Must be a current member of CSCC.

### Evaluation Criteria

- Production of research/scholarship that advances diversity, equity, inclusion, and accessibility for community colleges.
- Engagement in scholarly activities, such as teaching, conference presentations, grant funding, and publications.
- Contributions to service at a local, regional, and/or national level, including service to CSCC.

### Nominations and Supporting Materials

Candidates for the Outstanding Graduate Student Award must be nominated by a CSCC member. Submit the following required documents: (1) a single nomination letter (no more than 3 pages) outlining how the nominee meets at least one of the the award criteria and speaks to their potential for their trajectory of sustained scholarship, praxis, and service; (2) two additional letters of support (no more than 2 pages each) (e.g., dissertation committee member, peer/colleague; faculty mentor; student); (3) a curriculum vitae.
